- 1. Roll Call: All present meeting opens at 6:01 pm.
- 2. Additions/Deletions:

- 3. Title 5 Regulations PUBLIC HEARING cont' from 11/29: Board discussed definitions. They discussed the differences between 2 and 3 bedrooms. They deleted certain drain information and updated riser covers. They are date of new regulations will be March 1, 2023. A request for legal review from Town Council is needed. A MOTION was made by GB and 2nd by JL to have legal review their changes and accept once final with legal. Voting 3/0 MOTION carries.
- 4. **15 Depot Road Septic Upgrade**: House is behind the mobile station. Design in full compliance for a 3-bedroom home. A MOTION was made by GB and 2nd by JL to approve the septic upgrade for 3 Depot Road. Voting 3/0 MOTION carries.
- 5. **Lot 4 North End Road New Construction:** High groundwater and lots of fill but the plan is in full compliance for a 4 bedroom home. A MOTION was made by JL and 2nd by GB to approve the septic upgrade for 192 Lot 4 North End Road. Voting 3/0 MOTION carries.
- 6. **75 Pierce Road Increase in Flow**: Existing house is a 3-bedroom increase to 4 bedroom proposed. Septic tank will be replaced. Design is in full compliance. A MOTION was made by JL and 2nd by JL to approve the design for an increase in flow to 4 bedrooms. Voting 3/0 MOTION carries.
