Dear Supervisor Murray:

This is a petition submitted under G.L. c. 66, §10A(a) and 950 C.M.R. 32.08(1) of the Massachusetts Public Records Law and Public Records Access Regulation, appealing the failure to provide a timely response to a public record request committed by the Town of Townsend Records Access Officer (RAO).

Specifically, on June 22, 2017, I transmitted a public records request to the RAO via first class mail, postage prepaid. More than 10 business days has passed since the transmission of my request without receiving any response.

The RAO has a statutory duty to respond to my public record request within 10 business days. See G.L. c. 66, \$6A(b); G.L. c. 66, \$10(a); see also 950 C.M.R. 32.04(5)(a); 950 C.M.R. 32.06(2)(a). The RAO's failure to provide a response to my public record request is a violation of the Massachusetts Public Records Law and Public Records Access Regulation. The RAO is now required by law to provide all records responsive to my request free of charge. See G.L. c. 66, \$10(e); 950 C.M.R. 32.06(2)(c).

Pursuant to G.L. c. 66, \$10A(a), please command the RAO to immediately provide all records responsive to my request free of charge, in accordance with the statutory mandates of G.L. c. 66, \$10(e) and 950 C.M.R. 32.06(2)(c).

All associated correspondence under 950 C.M.R. 32.08(1)(g)1-2, is attached to this petition. Pursuant to 950 C.M.R. 32.08(1)(h), a copy of this petition and attachments has been transmitted to the RAO via first class mail, postage prepaid.
