I. PRELIMINARIES:

- 1.1 MM called the meeting to order at 6:12 P.M.
- 1.2 Roll call showed Members Present: Michael MacEachern (MM), Chairman, Nathan Mattila (NM), Vice-Chair and Todd Melanson (TM), Clerk. Guest Present: Rebecca McEnroe (RM) Interim Superintendent and Ryan Lapierre (RL), Foreman.
- 1.3 MM announced that the meeting is being audio recorded.
- 1.4 Chairman's additions or deletions. None
- 1.5 Approve meeting minutes of November 25, 2019, December 9, 2019 and January 6, 2020. NM moved to accept the meeting minutes of November 25, 2019, December 9, 2019 and January 6, 2020. TM seconded. Unanimous vote.
- 1.6 Review correspondence. None.

III. MEETING BUSINESS-VOTES MAY BE TAKEN:

- 3.1 Discuss the possibility of the public hearing being cancelled. (RM) stated that there is a possibility that due the Corona virus the June 3rd rate increase meeting may be cancelled. After a brief discussion the Board decided to table the matter until the next meeting to see if things will be back to normal. Brenda will look into sending postcards or flyers out to customers if needed.
- 3.2 Discuss/vote/approve Chemical Improvement estimates for Witches Brook and Main Street Stations. Wayne Bennet of FW Webb came out to look at the stations for the day tanks project. DEP is now requiring that our pumping stations have day tanks. Wayne also discovered that the bulk tank needed to be replaced. We are waiting for DEP to approve the plans that were submitted.
- 3.3 Discuss/approve operational protocol. The Board wanted to clarify protocol procedures for the Technicians during the pandemic. The board wanted them to be sure to social distance from one another, take separate vehicles and come to the workplace at 7AM and leave from the workplace at 3:30 PM. Duties that can be accomplished while working is to complete service maps, exercise gates, clean garage, wash vehicles, landscaping the office and stations etc. TM mentioned he would like to see the sign in and sign out and no leaving from the job site. He would also like to see the water techs sign in and out for the trucks and write down the mileage. Todd would like to see an SOP written for the operating staff. Todd said we don't need an SOP for clocking in and out as it is only a verbal request. MM reported that there is a ton of maps that need to be made. Todd said there is a stuff of compliance stuff that can be done from

home while they are out of work. RM stated that she asked Ryan to send her a schedule showing which employee will be on site.

- 3.4 Discuss/vote/declare screening committee members for Water Superintendent. (RM) stated that according to the Town Administrator's email he specified that the screening committee can be performed in private. If the committee brought a candidate to the BOWC and they wanted to interview that candidate they would be required to hold the interview in an open meeting. TM thought that the Superintendent's salary was too low to attract the type of candidate we are looking for. Todd stated that he spoke with the BOS and they indicated that we could offer a higher if it was supported within our budget. RM had been in touch with retired Water Technician, James Blanchard and he agreed to help with the search of a new Superintendent. (RM) also noted that Todd Melanson volunteered along with herself. NM moved to nominate James Blanchard, Todd Melanson and Rebecca McEnroe as the screening committee for a new Water Superintendent. MM seconded. Unanimous vote.
- 3.5 Discuss rates on schedule of rates and fees and vote on rate increases. RM prepared a PowerPoint presentation showing the current rates vs. the rate increases proposed nine years ago but not implemented. RM stated that the department need the increase to support the FY21 budget. The increase that is proposed is meters that read in 100 cubic ft. (748 gallons) would increase from \$3.00 to \$4.32 and meters that read in 1000 gallons will increase from \$4.00 to \$5.36. RM did advise the Board that an updated Master Plan was being prepared for the Water Department and the report may suggest another rate increase in the near future. Many service fees will be increased as well. MM would like to notify all potential contractors so they can apply for their service applications before the rates increase.

NM moved to accept the rates and fees as presented by the Interim Superintendent. TM seconded. Unanimous vote.

3.6 Vote to approve FY21 Budget. RM presented the board with the FY21 budget. After reviewing/discussing the budget TM move to accept the FY21 budget as submitted. MM seconded. Unanimous vote.

5.1 RM reported that the Main Street station pump is down. Sullivan will be in on the 20th to try and repair the pump. Currently the station cannot provide adequate fire protection to the condos at West Meadow Road. RM spoke to the Fire Chief to make him aware of the situation. Shepco started work again on the Main Replacement project. They cleared it with DOT. They will need to finish up the connections on the odd side of the road, installed hydrants, pave and landscape. Brenda asked if the Water Department can follow the same rules as the Treasures office and waive late fees during the pandemic. TM moved if allowable by the DOR & Mass GL's we can waive interest fees for the length of the state of Emergency exists. NM seconded. Unanimous vote.
